

Engraving Rules- First Presbyterian Lancaster Niche Covers

- All Font the same style

The style selected is Modern Roman Condensed (23 spaces available per line for the name.) The font size of the name is one inch and the date is 23/32 inch. Use standard abbreviations for months of the year: Jan Feb Mar Apr May June July Aug Sept Oct Nov Dec The standard font allows for the longest possible date combination possible to be centered on the cover, all subsequent date possibilities will be of equal or lesser length and will remain the same size font. Example: "Sept. 30, 2007"

- All engraving will appear natural in color without any background paint.
- Two lines available for the formal name. Lettering will be centered on both lines.

If the entire formal name can be engraved on one line, only one line to be used.

- No nicknames allowed.
- One line is to be used for the dates of birth and death.
- No names to be engraved until death.
- Each cover will have spaces for two names. The first death will go at the top. The second death will go at the bottom. If only one name is on the cover, it will be at the top.
